Received a call at the station from Lisa King stating that she was at the School Board Meeting and had placed a stack of pamphlets with information for those in attendance about some question about the curriculum, she states that she observed Superintendent of Schools Larry Leaven pick the whole stack of papers up and put it in his bag, at the conclusion of the meeting she asked him to return the pamphlets and he refused, she was reporting it as a larceny. Advised that if the documents were left on a table at a public meeting for the public to take that it does not meet the legal threshold for a larceny. Spoke with Superintendent Leaven, he stated that if the documents were left out and not part of the agenda that it was inappropriate to disseminate the documents and they were picked up, he also

stated that he took them and showed an example of the documents, he further stated that if they were left out for people to take he took them all and would not be giving them back, RO suggested that perhaps the appropriate course of action was to collect them and advise King that it was not appropriate and return them after the meeting, he declined and stated that it was not a police matter.
